The Bridge Youth Ministry will be partnering up with the Ichthus Music Festival to go on a 6 day missions trip and music festival this summer. We want to give you plenty of time to plan for this event so this packet will contain all the information you need to send your student on a life-changing adventure this summer.

WHAT IS THIS TRIP?

The trip consists of a mission trip to Downtown Lexington Kentucky and a Christian Music Festival called Ichthus. Sunday through Wednesday will be spent on the mission field of downtown Lexington: **JUNE 13-19, 2010**

PART 1: MISSION TRIP: SUNDAY JUNE 13th-WEDNESDAY JUNE 16th

Co-laboring with the Catholic Action Center among other local ministries in downtown Lexington, those that choose to serve at “LexReach” will perform a variety of tasks depending on the needs of the communities at that time; (isn’t it about time we as the Body of Christ start asking people how we can truly minister to their needs as opposed to telling them what we are going to do for them?) Each group will have the opportunity to prepare and serve lunches to the children of Lexington that are on the school lunch program during the school year, (that might not otherwise get a meal), as well as love on God’s people during a “Free Community Picnic.” Groups in the past have built playgrounds, picked up trash in a “homeless community,” organized and given away food, clothing and other personal needs to those in need.

PART 2: MUSIC FESTIVAL: WEDNESDAY JUNE 16th - SATURDAY JUNE 19th

Even though Ichthus has been around for 40 years there are still people out there who may not know who we are and what we're all about. While we have used music to draw the crowd, we are all about

WHERE WILL WE STAY?

Campus Housing Located about a mile from the Ichthus Festival grounds, dorm rooms are available on the Asbury College campus. Space is limited as there are only 450 2-person rooms available. All Campus Housing purchases must be made in advance of the festival through Ichthus Ministries.

2-person rooms (per the Asbury College fire-code)

- Large shared bathrooms for all room types except Family Suite - Air conditioning in all dorms
- 2 twin beds in each room
- Linen services are NOT provided. Please bring towels, sheets, pillows and blankets for twin bed accommodations - FREE breakfast on Thursday, Friday and Saturday mornings in the campus cafeteria. - FREE shuttle service to and from festival; shuttles run continuously all day (approx 8am-midnight)
- Reservations are NOT officially complete until rooming information is collected. Asbury requires you to supply names of all room occupants and medical release forms for any minors who will not have a parent or guardian present.
- After placing an order your receipt will be emailed to you. Your receipt will also serve as a housing form to collect rooming information. A link to the medical release form will be included in the email.
- Further details on check in, curfew, room damage, etc. will be emailed to you in early June.

WHAT IS THE PRICE?

WHAT DO I NEED TO DO TO GO?

1. Sign-up and pay \$50 deposit by Wednesday February 24th!
2. Fill out Permission Slip, Medical Form, and sign the rules.
3. Meals and Lodging are included, but you may want some spending money to buy CD's and T-Shirts.
4. You will need to bring a sleeping bag and pillow, toiletries, Bible, and clothes for 6 days.

THE ICHTHUS RULES:

We want to keep everyone at Ichthus safe and help them have a great experience. In order to do this we have a few rules. Read them, be aware of them and do your part to help everyone have a great time. Ichthus provides security 24 hours a day during the festival. More than 250 security volunteers work in cooperation with state, county, local police, and emergency medical services. Your cooperation with these officials and volunteers is greatly appreciated, and assists them in their commitment to a safe, quality festival.

RULES

- Youth supervisors and /or adult leaders are responsible for the safety and welfare of their youth group members. Ichthus is not responsible for any consequences of individual or group behavior that is contrary to festival regulations.
- All campers younger than 18 years of age must be accompanied by a responsible adult camper who is at least 21 years old. Ichthus strongly suggests a ratio of at least one adult for every 8 campers younger than 18.
- Any underage campers without appropriate chaperones will be asked to have a chaperone join them or will no longer be permitted to camp.
- Ichthus enforces a 2:00 am curfew. Campers are expected to be in their camping area and quiet at this time. At this time, the entrance gates will be locked and campers are expected to be in their group camping areas.
- Wristbands must be worn at all times during the festival. Those with lost or broken wristbands will be charged a \$5 replacement fee.
 - Group leaders are responsible for obtaining medical release forms required by law for minors. Please bring all medical and parental release forms with you to the festival and have them available to expedite any necessary treatment.
- Due to safety concerns, there will be no pedestrian traffic allowed on U.S. 68 but attendees may leave via the Kinlaw exit.
- No bikes are permitted on the campgrounds.
- Chairs and coolers are only permitted in the grassy area of the main stage amphitheater.
- No open fires are permitted on Ichthus property. This includes campfires and candles. Charcoal grills or gas stoves are permitted.
- Smoking only permitted in campground or designated smoking areas.
- No moshing, slam dancing, or crowd surfing is permitted at the Ichthus festival. Violators may forfeit their wristbands.
- Under no circumstances are *Firearms, Alcoholic Beverages, Drugs, Fireworks* to be on the Ichthus Farm. Anyone found to be in possession of these items will be dismissed from the campgrounds and the proper authorities will be notified.
- Lost and Found is located in the Barn. All lost items should be taken to or retrieved from Lost and Found. Always know the name or organization that your campsite is registered under, for contact with Lost and Found. Ichthus is not responsible for any lost items. After three months, all unclaimed items will become the property of Ichthus or donated to charity.
- Pets are not allowed on the festival grounds or in camping areas, unless needed for one's disabilities.
